“Because it’s never too early to teach God’s Word,” the husband-and-wife team of Edward and Sarah Bolme has created a wonderful series of board books specifically for the youngest, soon-to-be book lovers in your family! Baby Bible Board Books are sturdy, colorful, truth-filled books sure to delight babies and toddlers alike. The perfect size for little hands, I can just imagine toddlers carrying these beloved books to mom or dad, climbing up in their lap, eager to hear these stories of Jesus told over and over again.

We were sent the first collection of four titles: *Stories of Jesus*. This collection features the titles *Jesus Helps a Blind Man*, *Jesus Feeds the People*, *Jesus Heals a Little Girl*, and *Jesus Stops a Storm*. Each book features bright illustrations and tells these timeless Bible stories in short, easy-to-understand sentences. My favorite part of each book is the “application” on the last two pages. Transitioning from illustrations of Bible stories, the last two facing pages feature an illustration of a “modern” family with a faith lesson that teaches the “point” of the story and a Bible verse. For instance, after reading *Jesus Stops a Storm*, there is a picture of a boy in bed, with a lightning storm seen through his window and Jesus standing beside his bed. The statement on this last page is, “Jesus keeps you safe.” and the verse, Psalms 4:8 which says, “I will lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.”

Baby Bible Board Books are wonderful tools for parents to use to instill God’s Word in their children from their earliest days.

The individual titles comprising this very highly recommended series includes *Jesus Feeds the People*; *Jesus Heals a Little Girl*; *Jesus Helps a Blind Man*; and *Jesus Stops a Storm*. The *Stories of Jesus* collection is four small board books featuring Bible stories about Jesus. Each of the books covers one of the following stories; *Jesus Feeds the People*, *Jesus Heals a Little Girl*, *Jesus Helps a Blind Man*, and *Jesus Stops a Storm*. At the end of each story is an appropriate Bible verse and reference. These are sturdy books built to put up with the abuse of very young children. At about five inches by five inches they are small enough for little hands. These are highly recommended for Christian homes with small children, church libraries, and Christian preschools.

Taking four child-friendly Bible stories, the authors have transformed them into board books that toddlers will want to hear often. Small-sized, these books can be easily carried by small, chubby hands; and they tell favorite stories that show Jesus' miracles.

The authors have distilled each of these gospel stories into 10 simple sentences that will keep even the shortest attention span locked in. They include another Bible verse at the end of each story that complements the book's theme. For example, in *Jesus Heals a Little Girl*, Exodus 5:26 is quoted: "I am the Lord who heals you."

Simple, two-page pictures accompany the stories. Without many distracting details, these colorful drawings bring the stories to life for small children.

Church and school libraries that add these small books to their collections will undoubtedly see increased borrowing activity.
